CHANGES IN NATIONAL CATEGORY FOR SEASON 2023/2024

1. Here are **AGE REQUIREMENT** changes for **INDONESIA NATIONAL BASIC SKILLS CATEGORY** for Season **2023/2024** (effective July 1st, 2023):

Basic Starlet 1	Has not reached 8
Basic Starlet 2	8 and has not reached 11
Starlet 1	Has not reached 9
Starlet 2	9 and has not reached 12
Preliminary	Has not reached 11
Elementary	Has not reached 12

2. For **NOVICE COMPETITION**, we are following the **ISU Rule 108 paragraph 3 (ISU Comm. 2489)** for season 2023/2024:

Basic Novice	Has not reached the age of thirteen (13)
Intermediate Novice	Has not reached the age of fifteen (15).
Advanced Novice	Has reached the age of ten (10) and has not reached the age of fifteen (15) for girls (Singles/Pair Skating/Ice Dance) and boys (Single Skating) and seventeen (17) for boys (Pair Skating/Ice Dance).

3. For **JUNIOR MEN SHORT PROGRAM REQUIREMENT** FOR SEASON 2023-2024 in INDONESIA NATIONALS 2024:

- Double or triple Axel Paulsen;
- Double or triple Lutz jump;
- Jump combination consisting of a double and a triple jump or two triple jumps;
- Flying sit spin;
- Camel spin with only one change of foot;
- Spin combination with only one change of foot;
- Step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

4. For **JUNIOR WOMEN SHORT PROGRAM REQUIREMENT** FOR SEASON 2023-2024 in INDONESIA NATIONALS 2024:
- Double Axel Paulsen;
 - Double or triple Lutz jump;
 - Jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump or two triple jumps;
 - Flying sit spin;
 - Layback / sideways leaning spin or camel spin without change of foot;
 - Spin combination with only one change of foot
5. For **SENIOR category AGE REQUIREMENT** changes on a gradual increase:
- no change (15 years) for the season 2022/23,
 - an increase to 16 years for the season 2023/24** and
 - an increase to 17 years for the season 2024/25 and subsequent seasons.

This gradual implementation will allow Skaters to adapt gradually to the new age limits; therefore, FISU will follow these changes and guideline from the ISU for our SENIOR CATEGORY in season 2023/2024.

Below are the AGE REQUIREMENTS for NATIONAL CATEGORY in Season 2023/2024:

- Senior** 16 years old (17 years old starting from the 2024-25 season)
- Junior** 13 years old and less than 19 years old (21 for male pair/dance skaters)
- Advanced Novice** 10 years old and less than 15 years old (17 for male pair/dance skaters)
- Intermediate Novice** 15 years old maximum
- Basic Novice** 13 years old maximum

6. **Starting SEASON 2023/2024**, all skaters in 1 category **will be combined and NOT be separated between NATIONAL and OPEN**. Open skaters who will get into TOP 3 in the group will receive MEDAL only and will not get the NATIONAL TITLE. Top 3 NATIONAL qualified skaters in the group (according to the AGE requirement) in the group will get Medal, Trophy and National title.

In example:

Skater 1 (National)	1 st Place
Skater 2 (OPEN)	2 nd Place
Skater 3 (National)	3 rd Place
Skater 4 (OPEN)	4 th Place
Skater 5 (National)	5 th Place

AWARD:

Skater 1 (National)	Gold Medallist + Trophy (NATIONAL TITLE)
Skater 3 (National)	Silver Medallist + Trophy (NATIONAL TITLE)
Skater 5 (National)	Bronze Medallist + Trophy (NATIONAL TITLE)

Skater 2 (OPEN)	Silver Medallist

7. NATIONAL OVERALL TEAM CHAMPION (JUARA UMUM NASIONAL)

FISU will publish medal tally lists for informational purposes and shows the total number of medals won by athletes representing each pengprov. Meanwhile, the method used by FISU is to sort by the number of gold medals won by athletes. If two teams have the same number of gold medals, the next consideration is the number of silver medals, then the number of bronze medals.
