# 2024 Asian Open Short Track Speed Skating Trophy August 21-23, 2024 at Oasis Centre Arena, Jakarta- Indonesia

#### **General Regulations**

"2024 Asian Open Short Track Speed Skating Trophy" will be conducted in accordance with the International Skating Union (ISU) Regulations 2022 and relevant Communications. Participation is open to all ISU Members.

#### **Technical Data**

All events as well as official practices will take place at the Oasis Centre Arena (Address: AEON Mall, Jl. Jakarta Garden City Boulevard, Jakarta Timur) with an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface 30x60m. The compass of the track is 111.12 m, according to ISU Rules. Protective padding covers the boards in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and the respective ISU Communications.

#### **Competition Format**

All Final defined as:

Competition will use the knock out system (elimination system) as the qualification procedure. The set-up of the races will be made in accordance with ISU rule 296-3c), 4, 5 and 6. The lane positions of qualifying rounds will follow Rule 296-8. Final points (34, 21, 13, 8, 5, 3, 2, 1) will be awarded in the respective Final A and Final B considering Racing Rule 295-6.

#### **Eligibility and Requirements**

Participation in the 2024 Asian Open Short Track Speed Skating Trophy is open to all ISU members. Entries must be made only through the respective ISU Members.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

The competitor's division is based on age as at 1st July 2024.

A skater may enter only one category for the individual and two categories for the relay based on their birth date. The combining of categories, in the event if insufficient entries are received, is at the discretion of the competition organizers and officials. The participants will be notified by the organizing committee if any changes mentioned above need to be made. Detailed event schedule will be announced at a later date.

#### **Equipment**

Skaters will be provided with a helmet cover and a transponder. A deposit of 100 USD is required to be paid by cash upon accreditation. The deposit will be fully refunded when all equipment is returned at the end ofthe competition in a good condition. In case of any damage or loss, the deposit paid will not be refunded.

Skaters are required to use all safety equipment in accordance with Rule 291. Knee and shin pads, neck guards, bodysuits, safety helmet and gloves are compulsory equipment for all competitors and must be worn appropriately. There are no exceptions, else the skaters will not be allowed on the ice to race.

Blades used in the Short track events must be short track blades conforming to ISU regulations with tubes closed, and compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades with the blade ends

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rounded off with a minimum radius of 10mm.

This schedule is subject to change depending on the numbers of final entry. The team leader meeting and accreditation will be held at the AEON Hall A & B at the competition venue. Skaters are required to present their passport upon accreditation.

#### **Entry**

Entry forms including the competitor's passport copy must be submitted by email to the Organizing Committee at <u>fisientries@gmail.com</u> not later than **Wednesday**, **July 21**, **2024** – 20:00, local time Jakarta (GMT+7). Incomplete, incorrect, and late entry forms will not be accepted.

All skaters are required to provide their personal best time for all the distance that they intend to race. The personal best time recorded during the period of eligibility, for all individual distances they might participate in along with a proof of such time must be sent. Only results achieved after July 1, 2022, will be considered.

The OC reserves the right to limit the number of participants to five (5) entries in each category per ISU Member. Members who have requested for extra entries will be contacted if additional places become available after the deadline.

The entry fee is USD 150/skater.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

After the final entry on Wednesday, July 21, 2024 – 20:00, local time Jakarta (GMT+7), respective Member Federation will receive an invoice for entry fee. Entry fee must be paid on orbefore **Wednesday**, **July 28**, **2024** via bank transfer to:
